**Juan Perez-Flores Arraigned for Death of 20-Year-Old
Ashley Arroyo-Bautista**

Rochester, NY- 32-year-old Juan Perez-Flores was arraigned in front of Monroe County Court Judge John DeMarco after a two count indictment was unsealed, charging him with one count of Murder in the 2nd Degree and one count of Burglary in the 3rd Degree. In July 2016, the Rochester Police Department was called to a home on Wilkins Street in the City of Rochester. At the house, officers found the deceased body of 20-year-old Ashley Arroyo-Bautista. At the time of the victim's death, Perez-Flores was on parole for an Attempted Robbery in the 1st Degree conviction from 2009. Perez-Flores has been in custody since Arroyo-Bautista's death on a violation of his parole. He is scheduled to appear in Monroe County Court on April 26, 2017.
