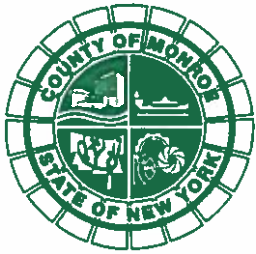

Honorable Legislators:

Under section C2-9(A) of the Monroe County Charter, the Legislature shall meet for the purpose of an organizational meeting on the first day of the New Year or as soon thereafter as practicable. Due to the large number of meetings between Towns and Villages within Monroe County on the first business day of the year, I propose to move the organizational meeting to Sunday, January 3, 2016 at 5:00pm.

Under section C2-9(B) of the Monroe County Charter and Section 545-4(A) of the Rules of the Monroe County Legislature, the Legislature shall meet on the second Tuesday of each month. The current November 8, 2016 Full Legislature Meeting will conflict with Election Day.

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 200 of 2015, the Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolution for County Elected and Appointed Officials for Retirement Credit Purposes.

The purpose of this amendment is to change the reporting for the County Legislator from the 8th District from Carmen F. Gumina to Matthew Terp.

This action is required by the Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York, Title 2, Chapter VI, and Part 315. The State regulations also require that the Clerk of the Legislature post the Resolution on the County's website for thirty (30) days and file a certified copy of the Resolution with the Office of the State Comptroller within forty-five (45) days of its adoption.
