Important Election Information

ROCHESTER, New York –

Primary Election season is upon us and the Board of Elections would like to ensure Monroe County voters are aware and prepared.

The following are registration and absentee application deadlines for the Primary to be held Tuesday June 28, 2022 from 6am-9pm. 2022 Offices to be elected can be found on our site at <https://www.monroecounty.gov/elections>

New registrant deadline – June 3rd
Change of address deadline – June 8th
Absentee application postmark deadline – June 13th
Apply in person deadline – June 27th
Absentee ballot return postmark deadline – June 28th

Early Voting will commence June 18-26, locations and times can be located at <https://www.monroecounty.gov/elections-earlyvoting>

Absentee voting is available and temporary illness selection on an absentee application can still be utilized by any voter through Dec 2022 if they have covid concerns and wish to vote in this manner <https://www.monroecounty.gov/elections-absentee>

CRITICAL – NEW this year, if an absentee is applied for, a voter can no longer change their mind and decide to vote on the machine. If a voter would like to go to a polling location during Early Voting or their specific site on Election Day they will only be allowed to vote by **Affidavit**.

Letters were mailed in April to all eligible voters and included important information as well as their current polling site.
