

This informational newsletter will provide periodic updates (as needed) on the status of the Highway Preventive Maintenance #10 Project and communicate upcoming construction activities to local residents.

CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

CONSTRUCTION WORK TO BEGIN ON SOUTH WINTON ROAD

Beginning on, or around, **Monday, May 6th**, Villager Construction Inc., a contractor for the Monroe County DOT, will begin work on the **"Highway Preventive Maintenance #10"** project. This project involves work on three roadway segments (as listed above).

Construction will begin first on South Winton Road; work will include:

- Repair and cleaning of portions of the storm sewer system
- Reconstruction of sidewalk ramps
- Repairs to existing curbing
- Milling and re-paving of roadway surface

Typical work operations will allow for two-way traffic to be maintained with daily lane closures, as needed. One notable exception is that the work at South Winton/I-590 (the "diverging-diamond" interchange) will require a **complete closure of South Winton Road (including the on and off-ramps to/from I-590).** This closure is <u>tentatively planned</u> to occur between Friday, May 31st through Sunday June 2nd (with the contractor working continuously between Friday evening and late Sunday evening). Portable Electronic Message Boards will be installed in advance of the closure.

The overall work on South Winton Road is expected to be completed by early-to-mid July, at which point, the contractor will then begin work on the next roadway (Brighton-Henrietta Townline Road). We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause, and ask for your patience during the project.
