Subject: Adopt 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body adopt the proposed 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program as recommended by the Monroe County Planning Board. The proposed Capital Improvement Program is submitted to the County Legislature in accordance with Section C4-10 of Article IV and Section C5-7 of Article V of the Monroe County Charter.

This proposed program includes projects designed to address aging infrastructure while at the same time ensuring that Monroe County continues to grow and expand its job base and quality of life. Projects contained in the program are intended to improve and modernize public buildings, construct needed highway and bridge improvements, as well as continue investment in public safety, the Frederick Douglass Greater Rochester International Airport, the County Parks System, the Monroe County Library System, the Monroe Community Hospital, and Monroe Community College.

The 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program is the result of a collaborative effort involving the County Executive's Office, Departments of Planning and Development, Finance (Office of Management and Budget), Law, Transportation, Environmental Services, Parks, and Information Services. In addition, the Monroe County Planning Board put in many hours in reviewing and recommending this program. I want to thank all of those involved in the preparation of this program for their hard work and dedication.

The specific legislative actions required are:

1. Fix a public hearing on the adoption of the proposed 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program.

2. Direct the Clerk of the Legislature to publish legal notice of such public hearing at least once in one daily newspaper of general circulation in the County at least ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing.
3. Adopt the proposed 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program, as submitted, in its entirety.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(27) (“conducting concurrent environmental, engineering, economic, feasibility and other studies and preliminary planning and budgetary processes necessary to the formulation of a proposal for action, provided those activities do not commit the agency to commence, engage in or approve such action”) and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

The adoption of the proposed 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.

Subject: Authorize a Contract with LaBella Associates, D.P.C. for Engineering Services for the Attridge Road Culvert Project in the Town of Riga

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with LaBella Associates, D.P.C. in the amount of \$178,398.80 for engineering services for the Attridge Road Culvert Project in the Town of Riga.

The project involves the rehabilitation or replacement of the Attridge Road culvert over Black Creek Tributary along with highway approach work and stream channel improvements. The current total project estimate is \$875,000. The current schedule is to conduct preliminary engineering and final design during the years 2023-2024 with an anticipated construction start in 2025.

A request for proposals was issued with LaBella Associates, D.P.C. selected as the most qualified to perform these services.

A cost breakdown of the services is as follows:

Design Services	\$ 75,382.07
Special Services	88,259.86
Construction Support Services	14,756.87
Total	\$178,398.80

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with LaBella Associates, D.P.C., 300 State Street, Rochester, New York 14614, in the amount of \$178,398.80 for engineering services for the Attridge Road Culvert Project in the Town of Riga.



Subject: Authorize a Contract with Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C. for Engineering Services for the Redman Road Bridge Project over Yanty Creek in the Town of Hamlin

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C. in the amount of \$237,739.46 for engineering services for the Redman Road Bridge Project over Yanty Creek in the Town of Hamlin.

The project involves replacement of a bridge on Redman Road over Yanty Creek in the Town of Hamlin. Work will include the replacement of the bridge, including abutments and superstructure, wingwalls, bridge rail and approach rail. The current schedule is to conduct preliminary engineering and final design during the years 2023-2024 with an anticipated construction start in 2025. The current total project estimate is approximately \$1,950,000.

A request for proposals was issued with Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C. selected as the most qualified to provide this service.

A cost breakdown of the services is as follows:

Design Services	\$130,492.59
Special Services	71,806.51
Construction Support Services	<u>35,440.36</u>
Total	\$237,739.46

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C., 11 Centre Park, Suite 203, Rochester, New York 14614, in the amount of \$237,739.46 for engineering services for the Redman Road Bridge Project over Yanty Creek in the Town of Hamlin.



Subject: Amend the 2023 Capital Budget and Bond Resolution 443 of 2022 to Provide an Increase in Funding and Authorize a Contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. for Engineering Services for the Phillips Road Project in the Town and Village of Webster

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend the 2023 Capital Budget and Bond Resolution 443 of 2022 to provide an increase in funding and authorize a contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. in the amount of \$445,402.28 for engineering services for the Phillips Road Project in the Town and Village of Webster.

The project involves the rehabilitation and/or reconstruction of Phillips Road from NYS Route 104 to Schlegel Road in the Town and Village of Webster. Work will include an improved riding surface, replacement of the road base where necessary, paved shoulders, drainage, gutters and curb, catch basins, edge treatments, signs and pavement markings. The current total project estimate is approximately \$5,800,000. The current schedule is to conduct preliminary engineering and final design during the years 2023-2025 with an anticipated construction start in 2026.

A request for proposals was issued with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. selected as the most qualified to provide these services.

A cost breakdown of these services is as follows:

Design Services	\$429,357.73
Special Services	<u>16,044.55</u>
Total	\$445,402.28

The specific legislative actions required are:

1. Amend the 2023 Capital Budget to increase funding for the Phillips Road Project in the Town and Village of Webster, in the amount of \$25,000, from \$425,000 to \$450,000 for a total project authorization of \$450,000.

2. Amend Bond Resolution 443 of 2022 to increase financing for the Phillips Road Project in the Town and Village of Webster, capital fund 2067, in the amount of \$25,000 from \$425,000 to \$450,000, for a total project authorization of \$450,000.
3. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., 61 Commercial Street, Suite 100, Rochester, New York 14614, in the amount of \$445,402.28 for engineering services for the Phillips Road Project in the Town and Village of Webster.



No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.
