Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize Monroe County to submit a Consolidated Funding Application for Monroe Community College (MCC) Downtown Campus Green Infrastructure Enhancements through New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation Green Innovation Grant Program (EFC GIGP) Funds.

Funds being requested through EFC GIGP will be used to construct green roofs on Buildings 3 and 16 at the MCC Downtown Campus. Proposed improvements include, but are not limited to: asbestos abatement, demolition, construction of the vegetated roof, and construction of public access to each roof. Estimates for the proposed improvements to the MCC Downtown Campus Green Infrastructure Enhancements total \$1.94 million. The local match required under this grant program is \$194,178, and will be funded through existing project funding to address structural repairs to Building 3.

The funding request for EFC GIGP funds total \$1.94 million. The local match required under this grant program, \$194,178 will be funded through capital fund 1665.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to submit a Consolidated Funding Application for Monroe Community College Downtown Campus Green Infrastructure Enhancements through New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation Green Innovation Grant Program Funds.

This grant requires a 10% local match. The match funding, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 1665 and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
