Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body approve the agreement among the Monroe County Executive, Monroe County Sheriff and the Monroe County Law Enforcement Association for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2023.

The agreement was ratified by the Union membership on March 16, 2018. The principal terms of this agreement are outlined below:

1. Wage increases*, generally, set forth as follows:

2013 - 0% schedule increase

2014 - 0% schedule increase

2015 - 0% schedule increase

2016 - 0% schedule increase

2017 - 0% schedule increase

2018 - 2.5% schedule increase

2019 - 1.5% schedule increase

2020 - 1.5% schedule increase

2021 - 1.5% schedule increase

2022 - 1.75% schedule increase

2023 – 2% schedule increase

*Increases shall not apply to the Entry Level. Court Deputies will receive a salary level equity adjustments spread out over five years.

- Court Deputies will move to a lower-cost health insurance plan with increased employee contributions. New hires will pay 20% of premium.
- 3. Changes will be made to retiree health insurance to reduce cost.

Economics of the agreement are substantially similar to settlement agreements with other County unions.

The estimated costs of this referral are:

2018 - \$128,494

2019 - \$266,930

2020 - \$350,790

2021 - \$617,502

2022 - \$726,945

2023 - \$1,170,859

The specific legislative actions required are:

- 1. Approve the Collective Bargaining Agreement among the Monroe County Executive, Monroe County Sheriff and the Monroe County Law Enforcement Association for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2023.
- 2. Amend the 2018 Budget Salary Schedule to reflect the agreement with the Monroe County Law Enforcement Association.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

Funding for this agreement is included in the 2018 operating budget of the County and will be requested in future years' budgets. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter receive favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
