Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body adopt a Home Rule Message in regard to the above bill which will amend Section 1210 of the Tax Law in relation to extending the period for the additional 1% County of Monroe sales tax rate and provide for the distribution of the additional 1% to the County of Monroe, the City of Rochester, and the various towns, villages and suburban school districts. Specifically, the proposed legislation extends the expiration date for the additional 1% County of Monroe sales tax from December 1, 2023 to November 30, 2025.

The net collections derived from the imposition of the additional 1% Monroe County sales tax for the period from December 1, 2023 to November 30, 2025 shall be allocated as follows (this distribution remains unchanged from the current legislation):

Jurisdiction	Percentage
Suburban School Districts	5.00%
Towns	3.00%
Villages	1.25%
County of Monroe and City of Rochester	90.75%

The amount allocated to the County of Monroe and the City of Rochester shall be distributed and allocated to each so that the combined total distribution and allocation to each from the sales tax revenues from the original 3% and the additional 1% shall result in the same total amount being distributed and allocated to the County of Monroe and the City of Rochester. This does not in any manner alter the sharing of the original 3%.

The specific legislative action required is to adopt a Home Rule Message for Senate Bill No. S.6149-A Entitled "AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to extending the authorization for the county of Monroe to impose certain sales and compensating use taxes."

Adoption of this Home Rule Message will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

Appropriate Unassigned Fund Balance to Provide Promotional Services Highlighting Regional Advantages and Authorize a Contract Amendment with Greater Rochester Visitors Association, Inc.

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body appropriate unassigned fund balance in the amount of \$150,000 to provide promotional services for our County and authorize a contract amendment with Greater Rochester Visitors Association, Inc.

We have the unique opportunity to connect with hundreds of thousands of visitors flocking to our community for events including the 2023 PGA Championship and the 2024 Total Solar Eclipse. The Greater Rochester Visitors Association, Inc., better known as Visit Rochester, is the official tourism promotion agency for Monroe County. Tourism is a significant economic driver in Monroe County and the greater Rochester region, with an economic impact of nearly \$1 billion, employing over 15,000 people and welcoming 1.5 million visitors every year.

In 2023, Visit Rochester has been providing promotional and marketing activities related to the upcoming PGA Championship at Oak Hill Country Club expected to have an estimated \$200 million economic impact to the region and a corresponding increase in Monroe County's sales tax and hotel/motel tax receipts. In addition, Visit Rochester has already been working with a consortium of organizations preparing the community for the April 8, 2024 Total Solar Eclipse. These two once-in-ageneration events have the potential to drive significant numbers of visitors to our community.

Visit Rochester will utilize these funds to help attract new visitors for these events, enhance the visitor experience through community welcome and engagement activities, expose and immerse visitors to the high-quality attractions to which our region is home. In the immediate term this funding will allow Visit Rochester to maximize and extend the economic value of hosting the PGA Championship, by engaging the PGA, its networking affiliates, and its fan base by promoting the region and all it has to offer once the Championship has concluded.

The specific legislative actions required are:

- 1. Amend the 2023 operating budget by appropriating unassigned fund balance in the amount of \$150,000 into Cultural and Educational Services, general fund 9001, funds center 8902010000 Authorized Agencies.
- 2. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to amend the contract with Greater Rochester Visitors Association, Inc. to provide an increase in funding in the amount of \$150,000, from \$3,367,500 to \$3,517,500, to provide promotional services related to large scale events including the PGA Championship at Oak Hill Country Club and the 2024 Total Solar Eclipse.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This contract amendment will require \$150,000 of net County support for which the appropriation of fund balance is requested.

I recommend that this matter receive favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
