



Bicycle and Pedestrian Crash Analysis

- Aimed to understand the countywide patterns of bike/ped crashes
- Three main components:
 - Data consolidation
 - Descriptive statistics
 - Corridor identification
- Used Safer Streets Priority Finder

 ■ Property Damage Only (O)





Fatality (K)	5.05%	5.06%	2.15%
Incapacitating Injury (A)	22.47%	13.27%	16.75%
Non-Incapacitating Injury (B)	25.78%	21.36%	17.74%
Possible Injury (C)	28.35%	45.67%	46.59%
Property Damage Only (O)	18.36%	14.64%	16.77%



Bicycle Crash Severity





Property Damage Only (O)	18.74%	20.78%	23.44%






Level of Traffic Stress

- Identifies bicycle facilities that are comfortable for all riders
- **Green** = low-stress
- **Red** = high-stress



Bicycle Network Analysis

- Three main steps
 - Level of Traffic Stress
 - Block-to-block connectivity analysis
 - Aggregation of destinations
- **Black/Purple** = high connectivity
- **Tan** = low connectivity


