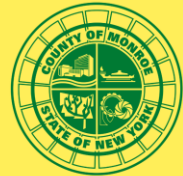
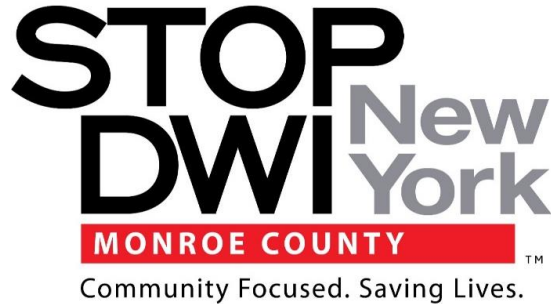

We're even available to come in and present to any group within the community (not just students) with statistical data, law related information or victim stories.

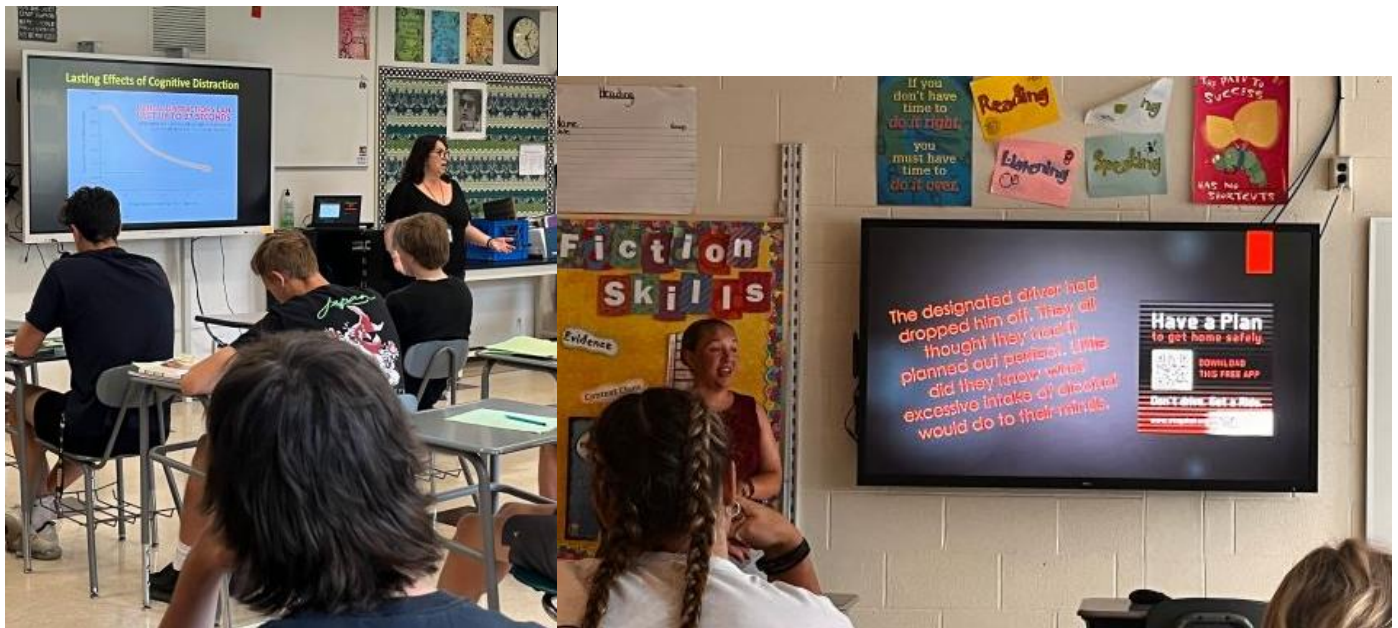

Groups for these presentations may include students during a health class, during a driver's education class (even in the evening), or within an auditorium setting for an entire student body. We can also do these presentations to companies within the community who'd like to promote safe driving to their staff who is on the roadways. Distract a Match

This activity outlines how important it is to minimize distractions as we are behind the wheel. With this multitasking activity, participants have 30 seconds to match puzzle pieces to the board while their minds are being distracted by counting backwards from 100. Our team provides the puzzle and stopwatch.

Host would provide the table for the pieces to be scattered on and one volunteer would be needed to facilitate the activity.

Distracted Driving Virtual Simulator

Our virtual driving simulator provides an actual steering wheel and pedal for the driver to experience the way distraction or impairment can interfere with safe driving. Our team provides the computer equipment and our staff will work the program with the drivers.

The host would provide a medium sized table that is not more than 1.5 inches in depth for the vice grips of the steering wheel. This table should be by an electrical outlet.

Alcohol Impairment Goggle Activities

Utilizing the goggles to simulate physical and cognitive impairment effects of alcohol, these activities help participants realize how susceptible they are to dangers of impairment even while walking, let alone driving. Goggle activities can include playing catch with a partner (suggested by a wall), playing corn hole or throwing into a green box, and walking forward in a straight line and back. Our team would supply the goggles of varying levels of impairment (2-4 available), the balls to throw/box to catch them and the corn hole setup.

Host would provide two volunteers to facilitate the activities in a fun, but also serious way. We have had police officers help us in the past, and would be happy to solicit their help within your area.

Marijuana Impairment Goggle Activities

Marijuana goggles are designed to impair a participant's visual perception and reaction time to show how this impairment could cause problems with driving. The activities utilize loss of ability to distinguish color as a means to demonstrate this. Activities can include a handwritten maze, catching balls of a certain color, or a grid mat activity where participants step accordingly with blinking lights. Our team provides one set of marijuana goggles and necessary activity items.

Host would need to provide a small table setup for writing if utilizing the maze. One volunteer would be needed to run this activity. We have had specific drug trained officers help in the past, and could solicit their help.

Pedal Kart Course

This activity utilizes our impaired driving goggles to show how the cognitive and physical impairment can put you at risk behind the wheel. 40 feet of cones will be setup in a “wavy circle” to create a lane for the pedal kart. Turns and harder elements will be part of this circle to make it difficult for the participants. Participants will have the impaired goggles on and try and pedal around the course in 30 seconds. Within the cones we will have pictures of objects they have to call out, proving they are paying attention. Our team supplies the goggles, pedal kart, image signs and all cones.

This activity takes up a lot of space. Host will need to provide 2-3 volunteers who are able bodied to work this. Volunteers will walk around the course to engage with the participants about their “failures” and may have to pull the cart back. Additional volunteers for setup are also helpful.

State Troopers Rollover Simulator: Our partners with the NYS Police showcase their rollover simulation trailer in an effort to bring awareness to seat belt safety. The test dummy flies out of the rolling truck to show participants what can happen if you aren't properly buckled during a crash where your vehicle rolls.
