ecopark



Monroe County's continual environmental protection efforts have again expanded to now include the "ecopark." The ecopark is a partnership between Monroe County and Waste Management of NY to provide county residents a central "one-stop drop-off" to recycle and/or dispose of certain items (see reverse) keeping them from our community's waters and landfills.

The ecopark will have two levels of services: **Regular Collections** and **Special Collections**. Regular Collections occur four days-per-week and Special Collections a few times per month. Appointments are still required for household hazardous waste items and fees will be charged for certain items (full details can be found at www.monroecounty.gov/ecopark or by calling 753-7600, option #3).

The ecopark web page also has a handy new search tool (ecopark Prospector) to give residents environmentally-responsible options for many items not handled via this program.
