- 2) It slows the growth of our landfills which are filling up very quickly and are very costly!
- 3) It reduces the amount of air and water pollution.

There are many ways you can help keep your Monroe County Parks clean and green:

- Employ the 3 R’s; Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle.
- Try using the latest green cleaning supplies.
- Be trendy and use those new fabric bags when shopping for your supplies.
- Use reusable, fabric table cloths - use extra or leftover cloth material.
- Utilize recycled content/biodegradable trash bags.
- Look for reusable or recycled material napkins.
- Avoid styrofoam coolers, they’re fragile and break easily.
- Utilize reusable ice packs.
- Try reusable water bottles- large cooler/thermos - Refill Not Landfill
- Use tupperware for leftovers- avoid plastic wrap and aluminum foil.
- Try reusable recycled, recyclable plates, bowls, cups and cutlery.
- Avoid idling cars, parking on grass.
- Become a green role model and pass these tips along!
