<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Children aged 6 months – 18 years -Pregnant women -People 50 years of age and older -People of any age with certain chronic medical conditions -People who live in nursing homes and other long-term care facilities -People who live with or care for those at high risk for complications from flu, including: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Health care workers 2) Household contacts of persons at high risk for complications from the flu 3) Household contacts and out of home caregivers of children less than 6 months of age (these children are too young to be vaccinated) 	<p style="text-align: center;">Phase 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Pregnant women -People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age -Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel -Persons between the ages of 6 months and 24 years old -People ages of 25 through 64 years of age who are at higher risk for 2009 H1N1 because of chronic health disorders or compromised immune systems <p style="text-align: center;">Phase 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Healthy adults from aged 25 through 64 years old <p style="text-align: center;">Phase 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Adults aged 65 years and older
