FREE 6 Hour LEAD SAFE WORK PRACTICES TRAINING

LEAD-BASED PAINT TRAINING PROGRAM

This 6-hour course is designed to teach lead safe work practices to homeowners who intend to work on a house built before 1978 that may have lead based paint. It also fulfills training requirements for owners applying for many grant programs. The course provides information on containment, minimization and cleanup of lead hazards.

The course does not provide certification or licensing of lead inspectors, risk assessors, abatement workers, supervisors or dust wipe sampling technicians.

Please note that this course is not an accredited course for the EPA Renovation, Remodeling, and Painting Rule. Holders of Lead Safe Work Practice (LSWP) certificates will require an additional four hour Renovator Refresher to fulfill the training requirement to apply with EPA to become a Certified Renovator. Alternately, one could take an 8-hour EPA Renovator course.

The Monroe County Department of Public Health is sponsoring this course. Space permitting, this class is open to the general public yet persons regulated by the MCDPH have priority registration. Course location: Rochester, New York. There is no charge for this training session but pre-registration is required.
