BIKE HELMETS MANDATORY

RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK

RIDE ON OPEN TRAILS ONLY

Respect trail and road closures, do not trespass on private land.

BIKES YIELD TO OTHERS


Bikers yield to hikers, dismount, and step to the side of the trail. Bikes please signal when approaching pedestrians.

LEAVE NO TRACE

Be Sensitive to the trail beneath you. Wet muddy trails are more vulnerable to damage than dry ones.

TRAILS ARE SHARED USE

Communicate with and respect other trail users. Ride, run and hike on trails in control and within your abilities

This beautiful Monroe County Park is located on the west shore of Irondequoit Bay and offers shared use trails plus access to the bay for fishing. Irondequoit Bay Park West's 147 acres are located along approximately 2,000 feet of Irondequoit Bay water frontage.

LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS




