## **COUNTY TO HOLD PUBLIC INPUT WORKSHOP FOR GREECE CANAL PARK IMPROVEMENTS**

*Residents are encouraged to share their thoughts and ideas*

County Executive **Maggie Brooks** announced that Monroe County will hold a Public Input Workshop prior to developing plans for future improvements to Greece Canal Park on **Tuesday, November 24, 2009** at **7:00 p.m.** All are welcome to come to Millennium Lodge at Greece Canal to share their thoughts and ideas for the Park.

*“Before we begin planning for upgrades or new features at Greece Canal Park, we first want to hear from local taxpayers, neighbors and park users,” said Brooks. “Staff will be on-hand to receive these ideas for further study and possible implementation. We welcome full community participation in this workshop in order to ensure broad-based public input.”*

The County’s Capital Improvement Program has allocated approximately \$2 million for Master Plan Improvements at Greece Canal Park. A Master Plan Update for the park was adopted in 1994. While a number of recommended improvements from that report have been implemented, many still remain.

The Public Input Workshop will be an opportunity for residents to provide their thoughts and ideas for Greece Canal Park in a relaxed and casual forum.
