Training

TEN members are eligible to attend all of the events that comprise the six-month TEN program including the Entrepreneurship Boot Camp, the Sales Effectiveness Boot Camp, the Investor Presentation Workshop as well as free admission to Private Roundtable Discussions and Public Panel Events.

Eligibility

Candidates should be founders, senior executives, CEOs or hold a controlling position in an early stage technology or life science company (in business less than ten years with revenues less than \$10 million), with business operations primarily in Upstate New York.

Application

Completed application forms must be received by TEN for review and acceptance into the six-month program. Class size is limited to 20 participants per class to allow for maximum interaction.

Cost

Approved applicants will be charged a one-time processing fee of \$350. Only accepted applicants will be required to pay this one-time fee in order to complete the registration process.
