RULES ON SHARED USE TRAILS

BIKE HELMETS MANDATORY

RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK

RIDE ON OPEN TRAILS ONLY

Respect trail and road closures, do not trespass on private land.

BIKES YIELD TO OTHERS

Bikers yield to hikers, dismount, and step to the side of the trail. Bikes please signal when approaching pedestrians.

LEAVE NO TRACE

Be Sensitive to the trail beneath you. Wet muddy trails are more vulnerable to damage than dry ones.

TRAILS ARE SHARED USE

Communicate with and respect other trail users. Ride, run and hike on trails in control and within your abilities.

Tryon Park contains 82 naturally developed acres on the western shore of Irondequoit Bay and offers hiking and natural scenic areas.

LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS


Tryon Park is located off Tryon Road off of North Winton Road between Browncroft and Empire Boulevards.

- Possible trail grades of 15% or less
- Unavoidable obstacles may be present
- May include loose rocks
- Unavoidable bridges
