1. Weds. March 2: Introduction to Planning and Zoning

Topics: A brief history of planning and zoning and using the land use planning and zoning processes to develop and implement municipal plans and ordinances.

2. Weds., March 9: Planning for Cycling – Why and How

Topics: The status of cycling in the Rochester region; the economic, health and environmental benefits of cycling; local, regional, state and natural cycling planning resources.
