JOB SUMMARY:

The Monroe County Public Defender heads a professional staff which includes attorneys and support staff. The Public Defender's Office represents indigent individuals in criminal court proceedings, Family Court, and Surrogate Court.

Services are mandated by state and federal law but are subject to some county control. In compliance with federal and state constitutions, the Monroe County Public Defender's Office is a legal service component of Monroe County government, which provides quality legal representation to its clients and contributes to the efficient and effective operation of the criminal justice system in Monroe County.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Essential knowledge of the New York State Penal Law, Criminal Procedure Law, Family Court Law, Vehicle and Traffic Law, and Constitutional Law.

Candidates for employment with Monroe County government will be required to pass a pre-employment drug test.

Applicants may be required to undergo a State and national criminal history background investigation, which will include a fingerprint check, to determine suitability for appointment. Failure to meet the standards for the background investigation may result in disqualification.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT:

Applicant must be a resident of Monroe County at the time of appointment.
