## **Passport Saturday To Be Held**

*Office Open from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., Photos Available*

Rochester – Monroe County Clerk Cheryl Dinolfo will hold a Passport Saturday at the County Office Building, this Saturday, December 30. The Office will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and will provide the full range of passport services, including photos.

“Passport Saturdays make it easy and convenient for families to obtain the gold standard of identification,” said Dinolfo. “I’m proud to offer this enhanced service to our customers and ensure that all interested residents can obtain a passport.”

The total passport application fee is \$97.00 for applicants age 16 and older and \$82.00 for applicants under age 16. The fees are set by the federal government and are the same regardless of where an individual applies. Necessary passport photos are also available for \$10.00 a set.

All passport applicants must present a raised seal birth certificate and should seek additional information on how to apply for a passport from [www.monroecounty.gov](http://www.monroecounty.gov) by clicking on the County Clerk link, or at [www.travel.state.gov](http://www.travel.state.gov).

The County Office Building is located at 39 W. Main St. in downtown Rochester. Plenty of free parking is available.

The Clerk’s Office will be open to handle passport transactions only during these special Saturday hours.

The Monroe County Clerk’s Office handled nearly 700,000 transactions totaling over \$80 million in 2005 including mortgages, legal filings, passports, pistol permits, driver’s licenses and vehicle registrations.
