

The Fish Hatchery at Powder Mills Park

The Fish Hatchery at Powder Mills Park was established in 1933 as a cooperative effort between the U.S. Bureau of Fisheries and Monroe County. It was closed in mid-December 2002 due to County budget cuts and then re-opened in the Fall of 2003, when the Riedman Foundation entered into a partnership with the County to provide funding for staff, maintenance and operational support, as well as make capital improvements.

The Fish Hatchery at Powder Mills Park is open all year long. This popular family destination provides a unique opportunity to view several varieties of fish in various stages of development. There are some 20,000 fish currently being raised at the hatchery. In addition to the trout, the hatchery raises Chinook salmon and Perch. Hatchery staff, on duty Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. most weekends, help provide an educational experience for visitors of all ages.

2010 Riedman Foundation Opening Day Trout Derby

Fun for the entire family and the most seasoned angler, the **Riedman Foundation Opening Day Trout Derby** to benefit The Fish Hatchery at Powder Mills Park will take place at Powder Horn Lodge from 7 a.m. to noon on **Thursday, April 1, 2010.**

Powder Mills Park is located in the southernmost portion of Monroe County. Enter the park from Route 96, south of Bushnell's Basin near Interstate 490.

Advanced registration will cease at 3 p.m. on Sunday, March 28, 2010. You may register in person at the Fish Hatchery or by mail. You can also register at Powder Horn Lodge on the day of the event between 6:30 and 7:30 a.m.

Entries submitted by mail must be postmarked no later than March 22, 2010.

There is a \$5 registration fee per person for participants age 8 and older. The tournament will not be canceled or rescheduled due to weather conditions. No refunds will be allowed. An awards presentation, including the prestigious **Bank of America Angler Award** for largest brown trout, will follow the final weigh-in, at approximately noon, at the Powder Horn Lodge.

The Derby will be conducted in accordance with State law: participants 16 years and older must have a valid fishing permit, trout must be 9" or longer, and only three fish per person, per day, may be kept. You may direct question regarding the derby to the hatchery staff at **(585) 586-1670.**

Derby Rules and Regulations:

1. Derby hours are 7 a.m. until noon on Thursday, April 1, 2010.
2. Participants 16 years of age and older must have a valid fishing permit.
3. Fishing for the Derby will take place in designated areas of Irondequoit Creek within the boundaries of Powder Mills Park. You may not fish in White Brook.
4. Participants must be in possession of his/her registration card at all times and present the card to Derby personnel upon request. There will be a \$5 replacement fee for any lost or stolen card.
5. Any contestant who violates Park rules or State Fish and Game laws will be disqualified from the Derby.
6. The Weigh Station will open at 7 a.m. Fish must be weighed at the weigh station by noon on the day the fish are caught. Anyone in line after noon will not be able to register their fish.
7. To enter a fish in the Derby, the contestant must have registered to participate prior to having caught the fish.
8. Fish may not be held with the intention of releasing it later for a possible larger fish. As soon as a fish is caught, the decision must be made as to whether it is a "keeper." Please handle the fish with the utmost care.
9. In the event of a tie, the length of the fish will break the tie.
10. There will not be any multiple category winners. Contestants may win in a single category only.
11. Decisions made by tournament officials are final.
12. The awards presentation will follow the weigh-in. Awards will be presented after the final weigh-in, just after noon on Thursday, April 1, 2010 at Powder Horn Lodge.
13. Participants agree to hold the Derby officials, sponsors, their agents and employees harmless from any liabilities of any nature for any accident, injury or damages suffered by the entrant during the event.
14. Derby entrant grants the Fish Hatchery at Powder Mills Park and the Riedman Foundation permission to use photographs, video, and other images of entrant's likeness or voice for any legitimate purpose, including but not limited to any broadcast, promotion, or advertisement of programs or events.
