COUNTY TO HOLD PUBLIC INPUT WORKSHOP FOR POWDER MILLS PARK MASTER PLAN

Residents are encouraged to share their thoughts and ideas

County Executive **Maggie Brooks** announced that Monroe County will hold a Public Input Workshop for the Powder Mills Park Master Plan on **Thursday, February 17, 2011 at 7:00 p.m.** All are welcome to come to Park Road Elementary School, 50 Park Road in the Town of Pittsford, to share their thoughts and ideas for the Park.

“While Powder Mills Park has been part of the Monroe County Park System since the 1930’s, a Master Plan was never compiled. This will be the first,” said Brooks. “A Master Plan will guide the long-term recreational use and continued development of Powder Mills Park. This informational workshop is offered for local taxpayers, area neighbors and park users to provide comments and suggestions during the initial stages of the process. We welcome full community participation in this workshop and throughout the development of the Master Plan.”

The Powder Mills Park Master Plan will identify potential improvements and recreational opportunities for the 380-acre County Park, located in the Towns of Perinton and Pittsford. The Public Input Workshop will be an opportunity for residents to provide any thoughts about the Park and discuss its future use. The workshop will be conducted in a relaxed and casual forum.
