HOLIDAY CAMPS

Holiday ski camps are a great way to learn to ski or improve your skills. Designed for children ages 5 to 17, each holiday camp includes supervised ski instruction from 10am to 2pm along with lunch and breaks. Advanced reservation are required as participation is limited.

LESSONS & CAMPS

- Youth Programs are for ages 5-17 and adult programs are for ages 18 and older. Youths must be 5 years of age by December 1, 2010
- Lesson Programs include four lessons. The first three 1 hour lessons are held at Powder Mills Park.
- The fourth lesson is held at Swain and includes an eight-hour lift pass, a 1 hour group lesson, and rental equipment (if purchased). Register at the Swain ticket window upon your arrival.
- Ski equipment is available for rent. Renters should arrive at the park 45 minutes before the start of the first lesson for sizing.
- Classes and camps are held rain or shine. Refunds are not issued for any program unattended. Make up lessons are not held for classes missed at the park. If severe weather prevents classes from being held, an announcement will be made on the ski report at 234-SNOW along with rescheduling information.
- In case of a serious medical injury or illness, or any other reason deemed appropriate by management, a credit voucher for like services, representing the unused portion may be issued for the current season at Powder Mills Park or Swain. Written requests must be directed to Swain Management within ten days of the incident along with a doctor's statement. A processing fee of \$35 will be deducted. Cash refunds are not issued.

LESSON REGISTRATION

- To register, mail the completed order form and payment to Swain. Starting December 26, 2010 registration is also accepted at the Powder Mills Park ski lodge during operating hours.
- Classes have limited space and are filled on a first received, first assigned basis. It is important to write down your 2nd and 3rd class choices.
- Only Monroe County Residents may register for classes prior to November 30, 2010. Non-Monroe County Registrants are accepted after November 30, 2010.

ADULT 4 TIME LESSON PROGRAMS

We have set aside Thursday evenings to teach adults and young adults skiing. This program is designed for those 15 years of age to 80 years of age. The program is set up to run four consecutive weeks with the first three weeks at Powder Mills Park. For the fourth lesson, each student will be given a voucher to Swain Resort to be used on any day of your choosing.

All Powder Mills lessons are 1 hour long, the fourth and final lesson at Swain includes an 8 hour lift ticket with a 1 hour lesson. Rentals at Swain are included in the package if the rental program fee has been purchased.

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Your Responsibility Code

Skiing can be enjoyed in many ways. At ski areas you may see people using alpine, snowboard, telemark, cross country, and other specialized ski equipment, such as that used by disabled or other skiers. Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk in skiing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Observe the code listed below and share with other skiers the responsibility for a great skiing experience.

- Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride, and unload safely.
