



SOUTH LINCOLN ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

This informational newsletter will provide periodic updates on the status of the South Lincoln Road project and communicate upcoming activities to local residents effected by the project.

CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

THE TEMPORARY ONE WAY SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC PATTERN SHOULD BEGIN THE WEEK OF APRIL 1. NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC WILL BE DETOURED VIA RTE 31F, RTE 153 AND LINDEN AVE.

For the safety of the workers and public, please obey the posted detour direction. Construction on the watermain and storm sewer will begin after the detour is put in place. Work is expected to begin at the south end of the project and proceed northward. Construction completion is expected by Fall 2013. Also, the construction field office is up and running. Contact information for our inspection staff is provided below.

Other Key Info:

- Town/Village of E. Rochester residents are responsible for maintaining sanitary sewer connections from their home to the main located along S. Lincoln Rd. Homeowners may want to consider replacing sanitary laterals while the road is under construction, since the County will not charge a permit fee and will only require temporary pavement restoration (Permit fee may still be required from Town/Village). If a lateral needs to be replaced after the project is complete, a permit fee and permanent pavement restoration cost will be the homeowners responsibility. Call MCDOT for more info.
- The project will replace water services within the right of way to the “curb stop” (shut off valve located near the road). The service from the curb stop into the building is the property owners responsibility. If your portion of the service needs replacing, it’s your responsibility to contact a plumber and have it replaced. Galvanized iron services can corrode over time, causing reduced water flow and leaks. If you have a galvanized service, now may be a good time to replace it. You can usually determine the water service material by checking where it comes through your basement wall or floor.
