RESOLUTION NO. _____ OF 2025

**ACCEPTING GRANT FROM NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR COUNTY
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SUPPORT GRANT AND AUTHORIZING INTERMUNICIPAL
AGREEMENTS WITH MUNICIPALITIES AND FIRE DISTRICTS IN MONROE COUNTY**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a \$500,000 grant from, and to execute a contract and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Health for the County Emergency Medical Services Support Grant for the period of July 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026.

Section 2. The 2025 operating budget of the Department of Public Safety is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of \$500,000 into general fund 9300, funds center 2408030100, Office of Emergency Management.

Section 3. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute intermunicipal agreements, and any amendments thereto, with municipalities and fire districts in Monroe County for the sharing and clinical analysis of first response data as permitted by applicable laws and regulations for the period of July 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year extensions.

Section 4. The County Executive is hereby authorized to appropriate any subsequent years of the grant award in accordance with the grant terms, to reappropriate any unencumbered balances during the grant period according to the grantor requirements, to make any necessary funding modifications within the grant guidelines to meet contractual commitments, and to enter into any amendments to extend the time period of the grant.

Section 5. Should funding of these programs be modified or terminated for any reason, the County Executive is hereby authorized to terminate or modify the programs and, where applicable, to terminate or abolish some or all positions funded under such program. Any termination or abolishment of positions shall be in accordance with New York State Civil Service Law and, when applicable, the terms of any labor agreement affecting such positions.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.
