RESOLUTION NO. ____ OF 2025

**AMENDING 2025 CAPITAL BUDGET INCREASING FUNDING FOR PROJECT ENTITLED
"CONSTRUCTION OF A 9/11 FIRST RESPONDERS MEMORIAL AT HIGHLAND PARK"
AND AUTHORIZING INTERFUND TRANSFER AND DECREASING FUNDING FOR
PROJECT ENTITLED "BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES"**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS
OF THE TOTAL VOTING STRENGTH OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF
MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The 2025 Capital Budget is hereby amended to increase funding for the project entitled
"Construction of a 9/11 First Responders Memorial at Highland Park" by \$144,000, from \$350,000 to \$494,000,
for a total project authorization of \$494,000.

Section 2. The 2025 Capital Budget is hereby amended to decrease funding for the project entitled
"Buildings and Structures" by \$144,000, from \$4,300,000 to \$4,156,000, for a total project authorization of
\$4,156,000.

Section 3. The Monroe County Legislature hereby authorizes an interfund transfer in the amount
of \$144,000 from the Department of Parks capital fund 1918, "Buildings and Structures," to capital fund 2085,
"Construction of a 9/11 First Responders Memorial at Highland Park."

Section 4. Funding for this project, consistent with authorized uses, will be included in capital fund
2085 once the interfund transfer requested herein is approved and in any other capital fund(s) created for the same
intended purpose.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe
County Charter.
