**ACCEPTING TWO GRANTS FROM U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT PROVIDER RELIEF FUND – HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES STIMULUS, PHASE I & II AT MONROE COMMUNITY HOSPITAL**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept two grants from and to authorize a contract, and any amendments thereto with, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Coronavirus Aid Relief, and Economic Security Act Provider Relief Fund – Health and Human Services Stimulus, in the amount of \$154,605.63 for Phase I and in the amount of \$1,280,328.68 for Phase II, for prevention, preparation and response to coronavirus for health care related expenses, or lost revenues that are attributable to coronavirus, at Monroe Community Hospital, for the period of April 17, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Section 2. The 2020 operating budget of Monroe Community Hospital is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of \$1,434,934.31 into hospital fund 9012, funds center 6201010000 – MCH Administration.

Section 3. The County Executive is hereby authorized to appropriate any subsequent years of the grant award in accordance with the grant terms, to reappropriate any unencumbered balances during the grant period according to the grantor requirements, and to make any necessary funding modifications within grant guidelines to meet contractual commitments.

Section 4. Should funding of this program be modified or terminated for any reason, the County Executive is hereby authorized to terminate or modify the program and, where applicable, to terminate or abolish some or all positions funded under such program. Any termination or abolishment of positions shall be in accordance with New York State Civil Service Law and, when applicable, the terms of any labor agreement affecting such positions.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

**Subject:** Acceptance of Two Grants from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act Provider Relief Fund – Health and Human Services Stimulus, Phases I & II at Monroe Community Hospital

**Honorable Legislators:**

I recommend that Your Honorable Body accept two grants from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act Provider Relief Fund – Health and Human Services Stimulus, in the amount of \$154,605.63 for Phase I and in the amount of \$1,280,328.68 for Phase II, for prevention, preparation and response to coronavirus for health care related expenses, or lost revenues that are attributable to coronavirus, at Monroe Community Hospital, for the period of April 17, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

The purpose of these grant awards are for prevention, preparation and response to coronavirus, essential for protecting frontline healthcare workers and ensuring continued maintenance of operations. The grant awards agreements call for Monroe Community Hospital, in connection with receiving the grant funds, to agree that it will not use the payments to reimburse expenses or losses that have been reimbursed from other sources, or that other sources are obligated to reimburse.

**The specific legislative actions required are:**


1. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to accept two grants from and to authorize a contract and any amendments thereto with, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act Provider Relief Fund – Health and Human Services Stimulus, in the amount of \$154,605.63 for Phase I and in the amount of \$1,280,328.68 for Phase II, for prevention, preparation and response to coronavirus for health care related expenses, or lost revenues that are attributable to coronavirus, at Monroe Community Hospital, for the period of April 17, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

3. Authorize the County Executive to appropriate any subsequent years of the grant award in accordance with the grant terms, to reappropriate any unencumbered balances during the grant period according to the grantor requirements, and to make any necessary funding modifications within grant guidelines to meet contractual commitments.
4. Should funding of this program be modified or terminated for any reason, the County Executive is hereby authorized to terminate or modify the program and, where applicable, to terminate or abolish some or all positions funded under such program. Any termination or abolishment of positions shall be in accordance with New York State Civil Service Law and, when applicable, the terms of any labor agreement affecting such positions.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c) and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This grant is 100% funded by the CARES Act. No net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
