University of Rochester Medical Center to Provide Ventilator and Pediatric Unit

Staffing at Monroe Community Hospital

## Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 138 of 2018 to amend and increase the contract with the University of Rochester Medical Center, from an amount not to exceed \$6,370,850 to an amount not to exceed \$6,591,877, to provide nursing, respiratory and physician staff to the Ventilator Unit and Pediatric Unit at Monroe Community Hospital for the period of September 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020.

Monroe Community Hospital maintains on file with the New York State Department of Health a Certificate of Need for a twenty-bed unit for ventilator patients and a five-bed unit for pediatric patients. The University of Rochester Medical Center provides skilled nursing personnel, respiratory therapists and physicians for the Ventilator Unit and Pediatric Unit at all times. Changes to the staffing model are necessary to enable Monroe Community Hospital to accept referrals of patients with clinically complex needs and to meet the needs of the residents on a specialized unit.

A Request for Proposals was issued with the University of Rochester Medical Center selected as the most qualified to provide this service.

The specific legislative action required is to amend Resolution 138 of 2018 to amend and increase the contract, and any amendments thereto, with the University of Rochester Medical Center, 601 Elmwood Avenue, Rochester, New York 14642, to provide nursing, respiratory and physician staff to the Ventilator and Pediatric Unit at Monroe Community Hospital, from an amount not to exceed \$6,370,850 to an amount not to exceed \$6,591,877, for the period of September 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c) and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this contract is included in the 2020 operating budget of Monroe Community Hospital, hospital fund 9012, funds centers 6203180000, Ventilator Unit and 6203190000, Pediatric Unit. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County Budget.

The University of Rochester Medical Center is a not-for-profit agency and the records at the Office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that it does not owe any delinquent Monroe County Property taxes.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
