**AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH FINGER LAKES HEALTH SYSTEMS AGENCY DBA
COMMON GROUND HEALTH FOR DATA COLLECTION AND PROGRAM MANAGEMENT
SERVICES TO SUPPORT ROCCOVID COMMUNITY HEALTH INITIATIVE**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with Finger Lakes Health Systems Agency DBA Common Ground Health for data collection and program management services to support the RocCOVID community health initiative, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for the period of August 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Section 2. Funding for this contract is included in the 2020 operating budget of the Department of Finance, general fund 9001, funds center 1209070100, State of Emergency.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

Subject: Authorize a Contract with Finger Lakes Health Systems Agency DBA Common Ground Health for Data Collection and Program Management Services to Support the RocCOVID Community Health Initiative

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Finger Lakes Health Systems Agency DBA Common Ground Health in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for data collection and program management services to support the RocCOVID community health initiative, for the period of August 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

RocCOVID is a community health initiative for the supporting and tracking of symptoms associated with COVID-19 conducted by Finger Lakes Health Systems Agency DBA Common Ground Health in collaboration with its clinical and public health partners: the University of Rochester, Rochester Regional Health, and the Monroe County Department of Public Health. The mission is to track COVID-19 symptoms in Monroe County and the Finger Lakes Region in an effort to curb the spread of COVID-19 and enable the region to continue to reopen in as safe a manner as possible. Finger Lakes Health Systems Agency DBA Common Ground Health will manage the initiative, collaborate with the clinical and public health partners, securely collect and maintain the data, and promote and market the initiative to increase participation.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with Finger Lakes Health Systems Agency DBA Common Ground Health, 1150 University Avenue, Rochester, New York 14607, for data collection and program management services to support the RocCOVID community health initiative, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for the period of August 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c) and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.


