Subject: Authorize a Contract with Keeler Construction Co., Inc. for Construction Services for the East Avenue / Wilder Road / Bennett Road Intersection Project in the Town of Parma

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Keeler Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$878,163.36, for construction services, for the East Avenue / Wilder Road / Bennett Road Intersection Project in the Town of Parma.

This project involves highway rehabilitation on East Avenue from South Avenue (NYS Route 259) to Bennett Road (CR-220). The work involves: widening at the East Avenue / Wilder Road / Bennett Road intersection in order to add a dedicated eastbound left turn-only lane, milling & resurfacing of pavement surface, replacement of sidewalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, installation of drainage pipes and catch basins, installation of a new 3-color traffic signal, installation of new traffic signage, and pavement markings.

The following five (5) bids were received on November 8, 2019:

Keeler Construction Co., Inc.	\$ 878,163.36
Nardozi Paving & Construction	\$ 974,914.00
Villager Construction Inc.	\$1,054,000.00
Sealand Contractor's Corp.	\$1,206,000.59
Hewitt Young Electric	\$1,571,662.40

The bids have been reviewed and the Department of Transportation recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, Keeler Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$878,163.36.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract with Keeler Construction Co., Inc., 13519 West Lee Road, Albion, New York 14411, in the amount of \$878,163.36, for construction services, for the East Avenue / Wilder Road / Bennett Road Intersection Project in the Town of Parma, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital funds 1874, 1906, and 1909 and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records in the office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that neither Keeler Construction Co., Inc., nor any of its principal officers, owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes. The principal officers of the firm are:
