**AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH POWER AND CONSTRUCTION GROUP, INC. FOR
CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR HIGHWAY LIGHTING REHABILITATION -

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Power and Construction Group, Inc., in the amount of \$2,253,655.20, for construction services, for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation - Northeast 2 Project in the City of Rochester and Town of Irondequoit, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

Section 2. Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 1868 and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

Subject: Authorize a Contract with Power and Construction Group, Inc. for Construction Services for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation – Northeast 2 Project in the City of Rochester and Town of Irondequoit

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Power and Construction Group, Inc., in the amount of \$2,253,655.20, for construction services, for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation – Northeast 2 Project in the City of Rochester and Town of Irondequoit.

This project involves the furnishing of all labor and materials for the replacement or upgrade of existing lighting equipment including poles, arms, bases, conduit, pull boxes, wiring, power points, and lighting controls, along with replacement of existing fixtures with energy efficient LED's. The project limits include the mainline expressway, interchange ramps, and parallel access roadways on NYS Route 590 from Tryon Park to Sunrise Crescent and on NYS Route 104 from Goodman Street to the Irondequoit Bay Bridge.

Major funding will be provided by Federal and New York State Department of Transportation funds in the amount of approximately 95% of the project cost with overall project administration by Monroe County.

The following three (3) bids were received on November 13, 2019:

Power and Construction Group, Inc.	\$2,253,655.20
M.L. Caccamise Electric Corp.	\$2,406,721.10
Concrete Applied Technologies Corp.	\$2,933,135.00

The bids have been reviewed and the Department of Transportation recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, Power and Construction Group, Inc., in the amount of \$2,253,655.20.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract with Power and Construction Group, Inc., 96 W. River Road, PO Box 30, Scottsville, New York, 14546, in the amount of \$2,253,655.20, for construction services, for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation – Northeast 2 Project in the City of Rochester and Town of Irondequoit, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.


Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 1868 and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.
