**AUTHORIZING CREATION OF SIX NEW POSITIONS IN PUBLIC DEFENDER'S OFFICE AS PART OF YEAR 2 FUNDING OF STATEWIDE EXPANSION OF HURRELL-HARRING PROJECT GRANT**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to create six (6) new positions in the Public Defender's Office as part of year 2 funding of the Statewide Expansion of the Hurrell-Harring Project Grant as follows: one (1) Senior Assistant Public Defender, Group 20 and five (5) Assistant Public Defender 2's, Group 17.

Section 2. Should funding of this program be modified or terminated for any reason, the County Executive is hereby authorized to terminate or modify the program and, where applicable, to terminate or abolish some or all positions funded under such program. Any termination or abolishment of positions shall be in accordance with New York State Civil Service Law and, when applicable, the terms of any labor agreement affecting such positions.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize the creation of six (6) new positions in the Public Defender's Office as part of year 2 funding of the Statewide Expansion of the Hurrell-Harring Project Grant as follows: one (1) Senior Assistant Public Defender, Group 20 and five (5) Assistant Public Defender 2's, Group 17.

These positions will be fully funded through the Statewide Expansion Hurrell-Harring Project Grant from the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services pursuant to Resolution 191 of 2019.

**The specific legislative actions required are:**



Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to create six (6) new positions in the Public Defender's Office as part of year 2 funding of the Statewide Expansion of the Hurrell-Harring Project Grant as follows: one (1) Senior Assistant Public Defender, Group 20 and five (5) Assistant Public Defender 2's, Group 17.
2. Should funding of this program be modified or terminated for any reason, the County Executive is hereby authorized to terminate or modify the program and, where applicable, to terminate or abolish some or all positions funded under such program. Any termination or abolishment of positions shall be in accordance with New York State Civil Service Law and, when applicable, the terms of any labor agreement affecting such positions.

Funding for these positions is included in the 2020 operating budget of the Public Defender's Office, general fund 9300, funds center 2601010000, Public Defender Administration. No net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.
