## Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Erdman, Anthony and Associates, Inc., in the amount of \$295,430.16, for engineering services, for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation Southeast 1 Project in the Towns of Brighton, Pittsford, Penfield and Perinton.

The project involves the rehabilitation of the Highway Lighting on I-490 from I-590 to NY 96 (Exit 28) including the lighting along NY 441 in the Towns of Brighton, Pittsford, Penfield and Perinton. The project will involve the replacement of some lighting poles, the replacement of some lighting conduit and electrical lines, as well as upgrade of the system to LED lights. The current total project estimate is \$4,100,000.

Several consultants were considered, with Erdman, Anthony and Associates, Inc. rated the most qualified for this project. Erdman, Anthony and Associates, Inc. proposes to provide these services in the amount of \$295,430.16.
