Department of Health and Extend the Time Period for the Beach Act Program

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 151 of 2015 to accept additional funding from the New York State Department of Health, in the amount of \$4,755, and extend the time period for one (1) year, through September 30, 2020, for the Beach Act Program.

By Resolution 151 of 2015, Your Honorable Body authorized the acceptance of a grant from the New York State Department of Health for the Beach Act Program. The purpose of this grant is to support the water quality monitoring program for the swimming areas at Ontario Beach and Durand Eastman Beach. Monroe County currently monitors the suitability of the swimming areas at these beaches and will continue this effort to comply with New York State and Federal regulations. This additional funding will be used to provide partial salaries and benefits of existing positions. This additional funding will bring the grant total to \$30,770.

The specific legislative actions required are:

- 1. Amend Resolution 151 of 2015 to accept an additional \$4,755 from, and to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract and any amendments thereto with, the New York State Department of Health, for the Beach Act Program, bringing the total program award to \$30,770, and extending the time period one (1) year, through September 30, 2020.
- 2. Amend the 2020 operating budget of the Department of Public Health by appropriating the sum of \$4,755 into general fund 9300, funds center 5806010000, Environmental Health Administration.

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This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c) and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This grant is 100% funded by the New York State Department of Health. No net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.
