Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an intermunicipal agreement with the Rochester City School District, in an amount not to exceed \$64,084, for an Administrative Specialist/Educational Liaison for Raise the Age youth, and a contract with the Center for Youth Services Inc., in the amount of \$150,000, to administer the Rochester Teen Court diversion program, for the period of January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020.

Per Resolution 263 of 2019, Your Honorable Body accepted a grant from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for the Raise the Age Legislation. The Rochester City School District will provide an Administrative Specialist/Educational Liaison who will work on behalf of detained/sentenced Raise the Age youth who may be/are released to facilitate re-entry into school or other educational programming. The Center for Youth Services Inc. will administer the Rochester Teen Court diversion program for nonviolent offenders.

It has been determined that both the Rochester City School District and the Center for Youth Services Inc. are sole source providers for these services.

The specific legislative actions required are:

- 1. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute an intermunicpal agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Rochester City School District, 131 West Broad Street, Rochester, New York 14614, for an Administrative Specialist/Educational Liaison for Raise the Age youth, in the amount of \$64,084, for the period of January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020.
- 2. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with the Center for Youth Services Inc., 905 Monroe Avenue, Rochester, New York 14620, to administer the Rochester Teen Court diversion program, in the amount of \$150,000 for the period of January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020.

Funding for these agreements is included in the 2019 and 2020 operating budgets of the Department of Public Safety, general fund 9300, funds center 2403020100 Juvenile Services Family Division. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The Center for Youth is a not-for-profit agency and the records in the Office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that it does not owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
