Amend Resolution 397 of 2019 to Amend and Increase the Contract with Siemens

Industry, Inc. for the Operation and Maintenance of Monroe County's Iola

Cogeneration Facility

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 397 of 2019 to amend and increase the contract with Siemens Industry, Inc. (Siemens) from the amount of \$1,251,158 to the amount of \$1,751,158, for the operation and maintenance of Monroe County's Iola cogeneration (Cogen) facility, for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, with all other terms to remain the same.

The increase in funding will allow for amendments necessary within the operating fund(s) appropriation, for the operation and maintenance of Monroe County's Iola Cogeneration Facility.

By Resolution 397 of 2019, Your Honorable Body approved a contract in the amount of \$1,251,158 with Siemens Industry, Inc. ("Siemens") for the basic operation and maintenance of the Iola Cogeneration Facility, which provides electricity, heat and steam to the Monroe Community Hospital and 111 Westfall Road ("County Facilities"). Siemens recently notified the County that major overhauls will be required to the engines at the IOLA facility. Engine overhauls and other major repairs are not included in the contract's basic operation and maintenance services authorized by the County Legislature pursuant to Resolution 397 of 2019.

The specific legislative action required is to amend Resolution 397 of 2019 to amend and increase the contract with Siemens Industry, Inc., 50 Methodist Hill Drive, Suite 1500, Rochester, New York 14623, from the amount of \$1,251,158 to the amount of \$1,751,158, for the operation and maintenance of Monroe County's Iola Cogeneration Facility, for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, with all other terms to remain the same.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5 and is not subject to review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this contract is included in the 2020 operating budget of the Department of Environmental Services, internal services fund 9020, funds center 8645020000, Iola Powerhouse. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
