BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 169 of 2021 entitled "AUTHORIZING ALLOCATION OF EMERGENCY GRANT FUNDING TO SUPPORT ARTS ORGANIZATIONS NEGATIVELY IMPACTED BY COVID-19 PANDEMIC," be amended as follows:

Section 1. ~~The President of the Legislature County Executive~~, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute ~~grant agreements, contracts, or applications~~; and any amendments thereto, with the organizations and in the amounts listed below, in the total amount of \$136,000; for emergency grant funding related to the COVID-19 pandemic maintenance and operation of the following arts organizations pursuant to County Law § 224, for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

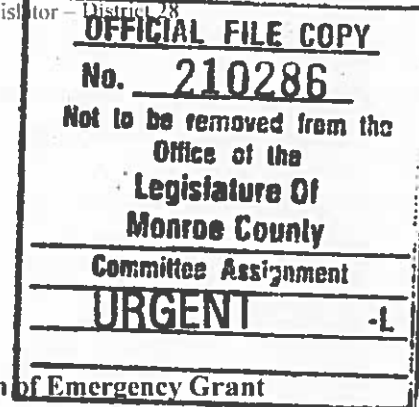

Subject: Amendment to Resolution 169 of 2021 Entitled "Authorize the Allocation of Emergency Grant Funding to Support Arts Organizations Negatively Impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic"

Honorable Legislators:

On May 11, 2021, this Honorable Body passed legislation to provide emergency funding to small Arts organizations that had previously received little or no funding from Monroe County. The County Executive vetoed this important funding on May 21, 2021, and his veto was subsequently overridden on May 25, 2021.

In order to prevent the County Executive from further delaying disbursement of this crucial funding, we are proposing an amendment to Resolution 169 of 2021 that the County Executive, after meeting with the leaders of some of the Arts organizations, has requested to help expedite this process.

The amendment authorizes the **County Executive or his designee, instead of the President of the Legislature, or his designee**, to execute grant agreements, contracts, or applications, and any amendments thereto, with the organizations listed below, for Monroe County to provide funding to arts organizations negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic that have not previously received County funding or received insufficient funding through the Mid-Sized Arts Grant budget allocation, in the total amount of \$131,000, for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021. It also removes the Irondequoit Arts Club as an authorized organization, changes the names of several organizations to reflect their legal designation, and adds language to ensure accountability.

It is our hope that this amendment will satisfy all parties involved, and allow for an expeditious disbursement of funding.
