ENACTING A LOCAL LAW ENTITLED "INCREASING INCOME LIMITATION REGARDING REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION GRANTED TO PERSONS AGED 65 OR OVER"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted by §467 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the Code of Monroe County, Section 357-2(A)(1), as last amended by Local Law No. 2 of 2007, is hereby amended to read:

(1) No exemption shall be granted if the income of the owner or the combined income of the owners of the property, for the income tax year immediately preceding the date of making application for exemption, exceeds the sum of \$26,000-\$50,000, except that, if the after said income is more than \$26,000 \$50,000, then such real property shall be exempt to the extent provided in the following schedule:

Annual Income	Percentage of Assessed Valuation Exempt From Taxation
More than \$26,000 \$50,000 but less than \$27,000 \$51,000	45 %
\$27,000 \$51,000 or more but less than \$28,000 \$52,000	40 %
\$28,000 \$52,000 or more but less than \$29,000 \$53,000	35 %
\$29,000 \$53,000 or more but less than \$29,900 \$53,900	30 %
\$29,900 \$53,900 or more but less than \$30,800\$54,800	25 %
\$30,800 \$54,800 or more but less than \$31,700\$55,700	20 %
\$31,700 \$55,700 or more but less than \$32,600\$56,600	15 %
\$32,600 \$56,600 or more but less than \$33,500\$57,500	10 %
\$33,500 \$57,500 or more but less than \$34,400 \$58,400	5 %

Section 2. Section 357-2(A)(1)(b) of the Code of Monroe County, as last amended by Local Law No. 2 of 2007, is stricken in its entirety.

Enact a Local Law Entitled "Increasing Income Limitation Regarding Real

Property Tax Exemption Granted To Persons Aged 65 or Over"

Honorable Legislators:

We recommend that Your Honorable Body enact a Local Law to increase the income limitation regarding the real property tax exemption granted to persons aged 65 or over.

New York State Real Property Tax Law ("RPTL") offers local governments the option to grant tax reductions and/or exemptions to individuals in need. By "opting into" a section of this law, a municipality can provide tax benefits to people who meet certain income limitations as well as other requirements.

Section 467 of the RPTL has been amended to allow a municipality to adopt a local law to increase the exemption schedule for persons sixty-five years and over. This proposed Local Law will amend the Code of Monroe County, Section 357-2(A)(1), as last amended by Local Law No. 2 of 2007, by increasing the income limitations regarding real property tax exemptions granted to persons aged 65 and over. The eligible income levels will be a 50% exemption for incomes up to \$50,000 and a graduated reduction in exemption for incomes more than \$50,000 but less than \$58,400.

The specific legislative action required is to adopt the proposed Local Law.

The Legislative Action required in this referral is not an "Action" as the term is defined in 6 NYCRR Section 617.5(b) and is not subject to review under State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This Local Law will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

We recommend that this matter receive favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
