## Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with M.L. Caccamise Electric Corp. in the amount of \$2,452,716.25 for construction services for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation Central Project in the City of Rochester and the Towns of Gates and Chili.

This project consists principally of the furnishing of all labor and materials for improvements to the expressway lighting on: I-390 from Chili Ave to the Genesee River, I-490 from the Genesee River to I-590, and the Inner Loop. Work shall comprise of lighting upgrades including LED fixtures, conduit, wiring, pullboxes, and replacement of poles, bases, and foundations. The current schedule is to start work in spring 2023 with an anticipated completion by fall 2023.

The following three (3) bids were received on December 16, 2022:

The bids have been reviewed and M.L. Caccamise Electric Corp. has been determined to be the lowest responsible bidder pursuant to General Municipal Law §103.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract with M.L. Caccamise Electric Corp., 721 Portland Avenue, Rochester, New York 14621, in the amount of \$2,452,716.25 for construction services for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation Central Project in the City of Rochester and the Towns of Gates and Chili, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(2) ("replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 1992 and any other capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records in the office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that neither M.L. Caccamise Electric Corp., nor its sole principal officer, Michael L. Caccamise, President, owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes.
