**ACCEPTING MAINTENANCE JURISDICTION OF APPROXIMATELY .092 ACRE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR FORMER NEW YORK STATE HIGHWAY (ROUTE) NO. 65, TOWN OF PITTSFORD**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The Monroe County Legislature hereby accepts the transfer of maintenance jurisdiction of approximately .092 acre of right-of-way for former New York State Highway (Route) No. 65 in the Town of Pittsford, at no cost to Monroe County, from the New York State Department of Transportation and to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute an agreement and any other documents necessary to complete the transfer.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

Subject: Accept Maintenance Jurisdiction of Approximately .092 Acre of Right-of-Way for Former New York State Highway (Route) No. 65, Town of Pittsford

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body accept the transfer of maintenance jurisdiction of approximately .092 acre of the right-of-way for former New York State Highway (Route) No. 65 in the Town of Pittsford, at no cost to Monroe County, from the New York State Department of Transportation.

The release of maintenance jurisdiction by the New York State Department of transportation, along with future right-of-way abandonments, will allow for future private development of this right-of-way and adjoining lands.

**The specific legislative action required is** to accept the transfer of maintenance jurisdiction of approximately .092 acre of right-of-way for former New York State Highway (Route) No. 65 in the Town of Pittsford, at no cost to Monroe County, from the New York State Department of Transportation and to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute an agreement and any other documents necessary to complete the transfer.

The provisions of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act shall be complied with prior to Your Honorable Body undertaking, funding, or approving the action requested in this referral.

This jurisdictional transfer will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
