Section 3. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Transportation for the Highway Preventative Maintenance #11 Project in the Towns of Greece and Irondequoit.
Section 4. The attached resolution required by New York State for the Highway Preventative Maintenance #11 Project is hereby incorporated by reference and adopted.
Section 5. Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, will be included in the capital fund to be created and in any other capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose.

Authorizing the implementation, and funding in the first instance 100% of the federal-aid and State "Marchiselli" Program-aid eligible costs, of a transportation federal-aid project, and appropriating funds therefore.

WHEREAS, a Project for the Highway Preventive Maintenance #11, P.I.N. 4MN017 (the Project") is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-federal funds; and

RESOLVED, that the Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Monroe to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal share of the cost of design work for the Project or portions thereof; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$457,000 is hereby appropriated pursuant to Resolution No. of 2023 and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project; and it is further

RESOLVED, that in the event the full federal and non-federal share costs of the Project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the Legislature shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the County of Monroe thereof, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive, or designee, of the County of the Monroe be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid and/or Marchiselli Aid on behalf of the County of the Monroe with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of project costs and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid and state-aid eligible Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible, and it is further

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary agreement in connection with the Project; and it is further

RESOLVED, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Amend the 2023-2028 Capital Improvement Program and the 2023 Capital Budget to Add a Project Entitled "Highway Preventive Maintenance #11;" Authorize Financing for the Project; Authorize a Contract with CPL Architects, Engineers, Landscape Architect and Surveyor, D.P.C. for Engineering Services, and the New York State Department of Transportation for the Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project in the Towns of Greece and Irondequoit

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend the 2023-2028 Capital Improvement Program and the 2023 Capital Budget to add a project entitled "Highway Preventive Maintenance #11" in the amount of \$457,000; authorize financing for the project in the amount of \$457,000; authorize contracts with CPL Architects, Engineers, Landscape Architect and Surveyor, D.P.C. in the amount of \$436,771.91 for engineering services, and with the New York State Department of Transportation for the Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project in the Towns of Greece and Irondequoit.

The Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project consists of the following highway locations: Stone Road from Mt. Read Boulevard to Lynette Drive, Culver Road from the City/Irondequoit Town Line to Irondequoit Bay Outlet, East Ridge Road from Marburger Street to Ridgewood Drive, Winton Road from the City/Irondequoit Town Line to Empire Boulevard, and North Goodman Street from the City/Irondequoit Town Line to East Ridge Road. This project will involve preventive maintenance including milling and resurfacing, storm sewer cleaning, curb and/or gutter repairs, ADA ramp replacements, and replacement of pavement markings and signal loops with traffic detection cameras at each location. The current schedule is to conduct preliminary engineering and final design during 2023/24 with an anticipated construction start in 2025. The current total project estimate is \$5,301,000.

Major funding will be provided by Federal and New York State Department of Transportation funds for approximately 95% of the project cost with overall project administration by Monroe County.

A request for proposals was issued for these services with CPL Architects, Engineers, Landscape Architect and Surveyor, D.P.C. selected as the most qualified for this project.

- 3. Authorize financing for the project entitled "Highway Preventive Maintenance #11" in the amount of \$457,000.
- 4. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with CPL Architects, Engineers, Landscape Architect and Surveyor, D.P.C., 255 Woodcliff Drive, Suite 200, Fairport, New York 14450, in the amount of \$436,771.91 for engineering services for the Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project in the Towns of Greece and Irondequoit.
- 5. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Transportation for the Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project in the Towns of Greece and Irondequoit.
- 6. Incorporate by reference and adopt the attached resolution required by New York State for the Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(2) ("replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, will be included in the capital fund to be created and in any other capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

RESOLVED, that in the event the full federal and non-federal share costs of the Project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the Legislature shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the County of Monroe thereof, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive, or designee, of the County of the Monroe be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid and/or Marchiselli Aid on behalf of the County of the Monroe with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of project costs and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid and state-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible, and it is further

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary agreement in connection with the Project; and it is further

RESOLVED, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
