Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body adopt a Home Rule Message resolution for Assembly Bill No. A.6724, which will allow Monroe County's Rochester Pure Waters District (the "District") to acquire 40-foot wide permanent easements (a total of approximately 40,250 square feet or 0.92 acres) from the City of Rochester (the "City") through Genesee Valley Park.

The easements are necessary for the construction and maintenance of subsurface sewerage facilities associated with its Genesee Valley Pump Station Project (the "Project"). The Project includes installation of an approximately 1,490 linear foot sanitary sewer facilities though Genesee Valley Park and under the Genesee River to relieve an existing District trunk sewer of peak sanitary flows. Your Honorable Body, through Bond Resolution 286 of 2021, authorized financing for this Project in the amount of \$5,500,000. Through Resolution 294 of 2021, Your Honorable Body approved contracts with MRB Group for professional engineering services and with the University of Rochester for financial participation in and the conveyance of interest in real property for the Project.

The specific legislative action required is to adopt a Home Rule Message resolution for Senate Assembly Bill No. A.6724 Entitled "AN ACT in relation to authorizing the city of Rochester to convey by appropriate instruments to the Rochester Pure Waters District, an easement in Genesee Valley Park, for installation and maintenance of sanitary sewer facilities."

This action is a Type I Action under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"). Pursuant to Resolution 292 of 2021, the Monroe County Legislature issued a Negative Declaration for this action. No further action under SEQRA is required.

Adoption of this Home Rule Message will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter receive favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
