Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an intermunicipal agreement with the Hilton Parma Fire District for the storage and deployment of the Monroe County Hazardous Materials Response Trailer (Fleet #4183).

The Hazardous Materials Response Trailer contains equipment and resources used to support mass decontamination, highway/cargo truck type incidents, and radiological monitoring in response to a Ginna event, and carries bulk safety and personal protective equipment. The Trailer will respond as needed to certain hazardous materials incidents in the community.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute an intermunicipal agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Hilton Parma Fire District for the storage and deployment of the Monroe County Hazardous Materials Response Trailer (Fleet #4183)

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.
