AMENDING RESOLUTION 103 OF 2024 ACCEPTING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FROM UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE WESTERN DISTRICT OF NEW YORK FOR UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE NY/NJ REGIONAL FUGITIVE TASK FORCE-ROCHESTER DIVISION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Resolution 103 of 2024 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a grant in an amount not to exceed ~~\$35,000~~ \$43,000 and to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with the United States Department of Justice, United States Marshals Service Western District of New York for the reimbursement of overtime for the United States Marshals Service New York/New Jersey Regional Fugitive Task Force-Rochester Division for the period of October 2, 2023 through September 30, 2024.

Section 2. The 2024 operating budget of the Office of the Sheriff is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of \$8,000 into general fund 9300, funds center 3803010000, Police Bureau Administration.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

Subject: Amend Resolution 103 of 2024 to Accept Additional Funding from the United States Department of Justice, United States Marshals Service Western District of New York for the United States Marshals Service NY/NJ Regional Fugitive Task Force-Rochester Division

Honorable Legislators:

This matter is being referred to Your Honorable Body at the request of Sheriff Todd K. Baxter.

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 103 of 2024 to accept additional funding from the United States Department of Justice, United States Marshals Service ("USMS") Western District of New York for the United States Marshals Service NY/NJ Regional Fugitive Task Force-Rochester Division in the amount of \$8,000 for the reimbursement of overtime for the period of October 2, 2023 through September 30, 2024.

This grant continues to support the collaborative task force with the USMS to investigate, apprehend, and arrest violent felony fugitives. The grant will reimburse a portion of the overtime costs associated with the task force services. This is the fourteenth year the county has received this grant. This additional funding will bring the grant total to \$43,000.

The specific legislative actions required are:

1. Amend Resolution 103 of 2024 to accept an additional \$8,000 from, and to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract and any amendments thereto, with the United States Department of Justice, United States Marshals Service Western District of New York for the United States Marshals Service NY/NJ Regional Fugitive Task Force-Rochester Division for the reimbursement of overtime for the period of October 2, 2023 through September 30, 2024.

2. Amend the 2024 operating budget of the Office of the Sheriff by appropriating the sum of \$8,000 into general fund 9300, funds center 3803010000, Police Bureau Administration.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act

This grant is 100% funded by the United States Department of Justice, United States Marshals Service Western District of New York. No net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
