Subject: Authorizing an Agreement with the Theta Omicron Chapter of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity for a Commercial Event to be Held at the Roger Robach Community Center in 2024

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an agreement with the Theta Omicron chapter of the Omega Psi Phi fraternity to permit the commercial use of the Roger Robach Community Center for a ticketed fundraiser on May 11, 2024.

As part of this licensing process, Theta Omicron would be required to pay the normal daily rental fee established in the 2024 Monroe County Budget for the Robach Center of \$1000, as well as a standard Special Use Event Permit fee of \$50, the budget-authorized rate for all events with under 250 participants. The event organizers would be required to submit proof of liability insurance as required for parks special events, and proof of appropriate licensing or permitting for other activities subject to such restrictions (e.g., NYS Liquor Authority permits for bartenders serving patrons at the event). This is the first instance of this event being held in a Monroe County Parks facility.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize an agreement with the Theta Omicron chapter of the Omega Psi Phi fraternity to permit the commercial use of the Roger Robach Community Center for a ticketed fundraiser on May 11, 2024.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(21) ("minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no permanent impact on the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This license agreement is revenue generating and no net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records of the Office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that Theta Omicron does not owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes.

I recommend that this matter receive favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
