Section 2. The 2025 operating budget of the Department of Human Services, Division of Social Services is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of \$22,987 into general fund 9300, funds center 510201000, Child and Family Services Administration.
Section 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend Resolution 89 of 2023, as amended by Resolution 13 of 2024, to accept additional funding from the United States Children's Bureau, an Office of the Administration for Children and Families, through a subcontract with the University of Connecticut in the amount of \$22,987 for Improving Systems and Implementing Interventions to Support Lasting Reunification of Families for the period of January 1, 2023 through September 29, 2025.

By Resolution 89 of 2023, as Amended by Resolution 13 of 2024, Your Honorable Body authorized the acceptance of a grant from the United States Children's Bureau through a subcontract with the University of Connecticut. The award is to develop, integrate, and evaluate best practices and innovative interventions that will improve outcomes for children and youth in foster care with a goal of reunification with their parents and families. The additional funding will be used to continue to support this program. The additional funding will bring the grant's total to \$857,182.

The specific legislative actions required are:

- 1. Amend Resolution 89 of 2023, as amended by Resolution 13 of 2024, to accept an additional \$22,987 from, and to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract and any amendments thereto with, the United States Children's Bureau, an Office of the Administration for Children and Families, through a subcontract with the University of Connecticut for Improving Systems and Implementing Interventions to Support Lasting Reunification of Families, bringing the total program award to \$857,182 for the period of January 1, 2023 through September 29, 2025.
- 2. Amend the 2025 operating budget of the Department of Human Services, Division of Social Services by appropriating the sum of \$22,987 into general fund 9300, funds center 5102010000, Child and Family Services Administration.
