AUTHORIZING INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENTS WITH MONROE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICTS FOR SECURITY ASSISTANCE AND CROWD CONTROL AT SPECIAL EVENTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into intermunicipal agreements, and any amendments thereto, with school districts in Monroe County for general security assistance and crowd control at special events at the Sheriff's applicable hourly overtime rate (road deputy) for the period of May 20, 2025 through May 19, 2028.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

Subject: Authorizing Intermunicipal Agreements with Monroe County School Districts for Security Assistance and Crowd Control at Special Events

Honorable Legislators:

This matter is being referred to Your Honorable Body at the request of Sheriff Todd K. Baxter.

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize intermunicipal agreements with school districts in Monroe County for general security assistance and crowd control at special events at the Sheriff's applicable hourly overtime rate (road deputy) for the period of May 20, 2025 through May 19, 2028.

Under this agreement, the Monroe County Sheriff's Office will provide general security assistance and crowd control at special events as requested by Monroe County School Districts when manpower permits at the current overtime rate for a road deputy.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to enter into intermunicipal agreements, and any amendments thereto, with school districts in Monroe County for general security assistance and crowd control at special events at the Sheriff's applicable hourly overtime rate (road deputy) for the period of May 20, 2025 through May 19, 2028.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This contract is revenue generating and no net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
