Department of Public Safety, Office of Probation - Community Corrections

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize the creation of one (1) Probation Supervisor, Group 34, and one (1) Senior Probation Officer, Group 37, in the Monroe County Department of Public Safety, Office of Probation – Community Corrections ("Probation").

These positions are necessary as a result of the County's assumption of direct delivery of pre-trial services. The County has a statutory requirement to provide such pre-trial services to the court system. Probation is assuming the responsibility for delivery of pre-trial services directly, instead of providing those services through a contractor. This effort will result in efficiencies through the reduction of administrative overhead. Additionally, it is expected that the alignment of services and programs from initial appearance through probation will better serve justice-involved individuals.

The assumption of direct delivery of these services will require appropriate supervision of pre-trial services personnel and activities, and the positions requested here are necessary to provide that supervision.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the creation of one (1) Probation Supervisor, Group 34, and one (1) Senior Probation Officer, Group 37, in the Monroe County Department of Public Safety, Office of Probation – Community Corrections.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this position is included in the 2025 operating budget of the Department of Public Safety, general fund 9001, funds center 2403060000, Alternatives to Jail. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
