Subject: Authorize an Intermunicipal Agreement with the Barnard Fire District for the Storage and Deployment of the Monroe County Special Operations Unit Response Truck

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an intermunicipal agreement with the Barnard Fire District for the storage and deployment of the Monroe County Special Operations Unit Response Truck (Fleet #4974)

The Special Operations Unit Response Truck contains equipment and resources used to support technical rescue operations, store and transport collapse and trench rescue equipment and materials. The Truck will respond as needed to all level one activations of the Monroe County Special Operations Unit (Technical Rescue Unit) within the community.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute an intermunicipal agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Barnard Fire District for the storage and deployment of the Monroe County Special Operations Unit Response Truck (Fleet #4974).

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(26) ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

This intermunicipal agreement will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
